



Uniform Policy

The wearing of school uniform is strongly encouraged and adds to the safety and well-being of all of our students.

Our school colours are bottle green and black with a white logo.

Our dress code is described as uniform items on top and plain black items on the bottom.

We are a sun smart school.

All items are available through the school, either from stock on hand or ordered and pre-paid, for delivery at the finance office at any point.

The school dress is not able to be ordered from the finance office but can be purchased from local department stores.

Tops

- Polo shirt, with school logo, bottle green, long or short sleeve
- Polo shirt, for seniors (year 6&7), short sleeve
- Windcheater with school logo
- Polar fleece zipped jacket with school logo
- Green and white checked dress
- Visible long sleeved shirts worn under school polo shirt must be in school colours, bottle green or black
- Year 7s are able to wear a specially designed jumper in bottle green

Bottoms (plain coloured, black)

- Casual or cargo shorts
- Casual or cargo pants
- Track pants
- Skorts
- Netball skirts

Hats (with school logo)

- Bucket
- Slouch
- Legionnaire

Wearing hats is compulsory from September to May inclusive. Students without a hat are directed to stay in the shade of the Room 13.2 verandah.

Beanies and scarves are also available from the finance office and may be worn from June to August.

Footwear

- Must be safe and well fitting and allow students to safely and actively participate in all school activities

Wearing costume jewellery and / or make up is discouraged at our school.
